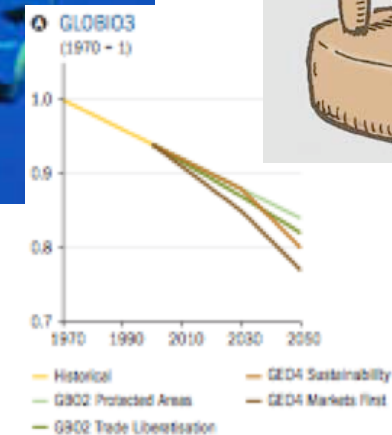

The footprint of the BiodivERsA consortium: pan-European coordination and promotion of research on biodiversity and ecosystem services

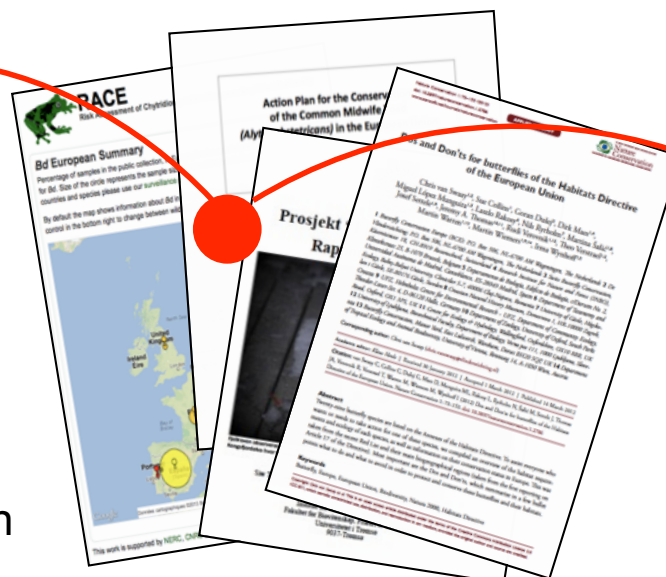




The footprint of BiodivERsA projects: excellence of actual academic AND societal outcomes

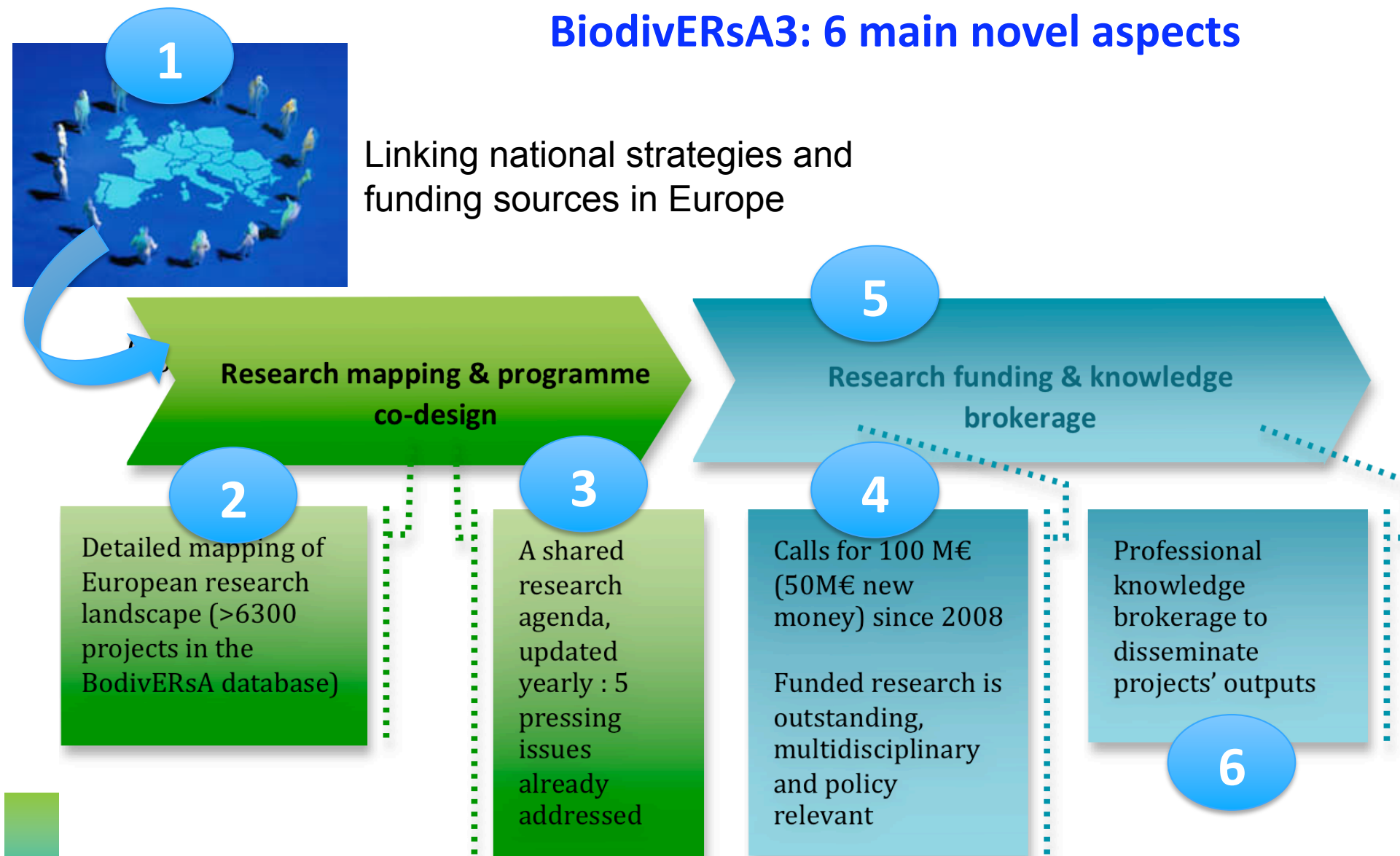

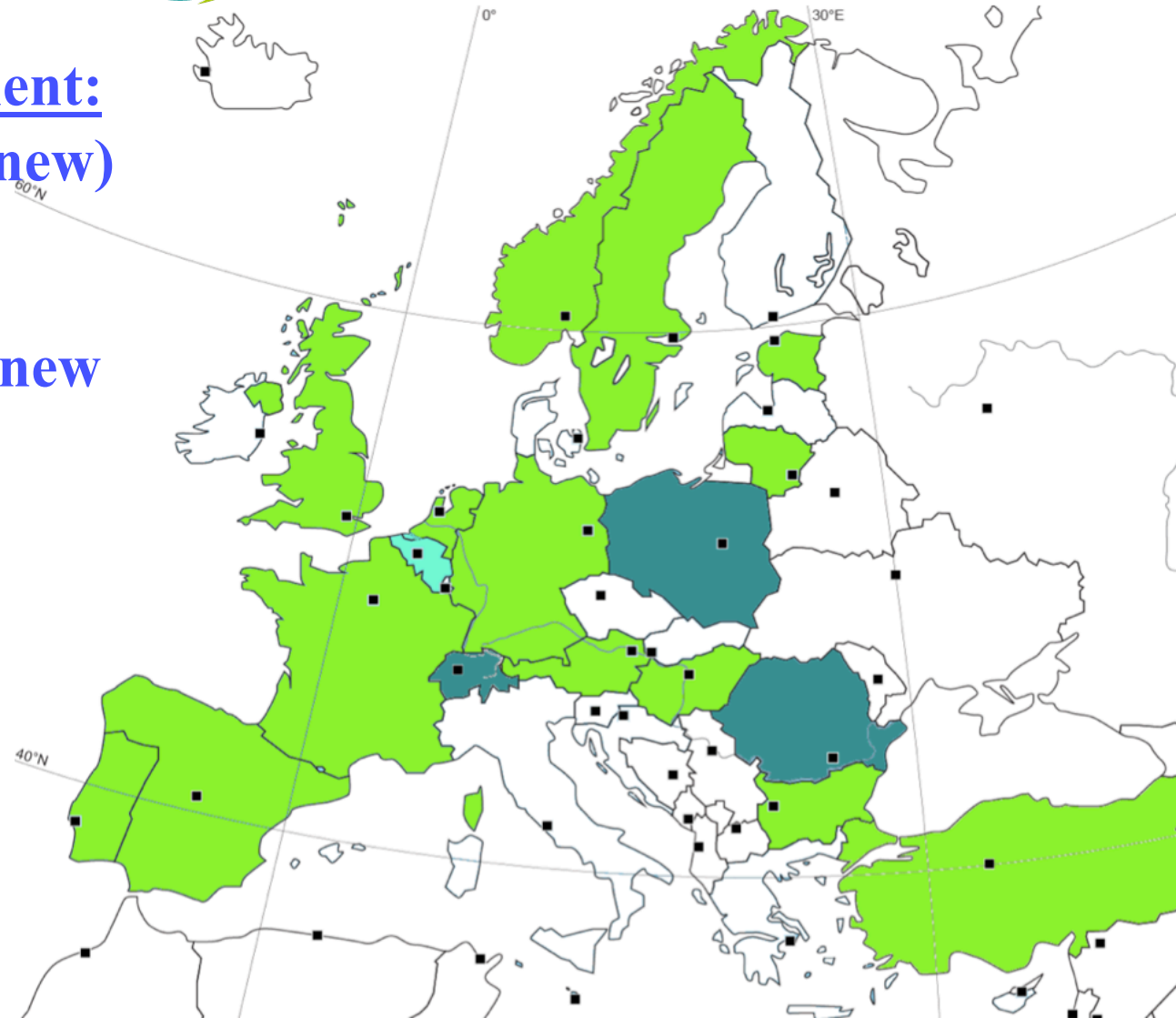

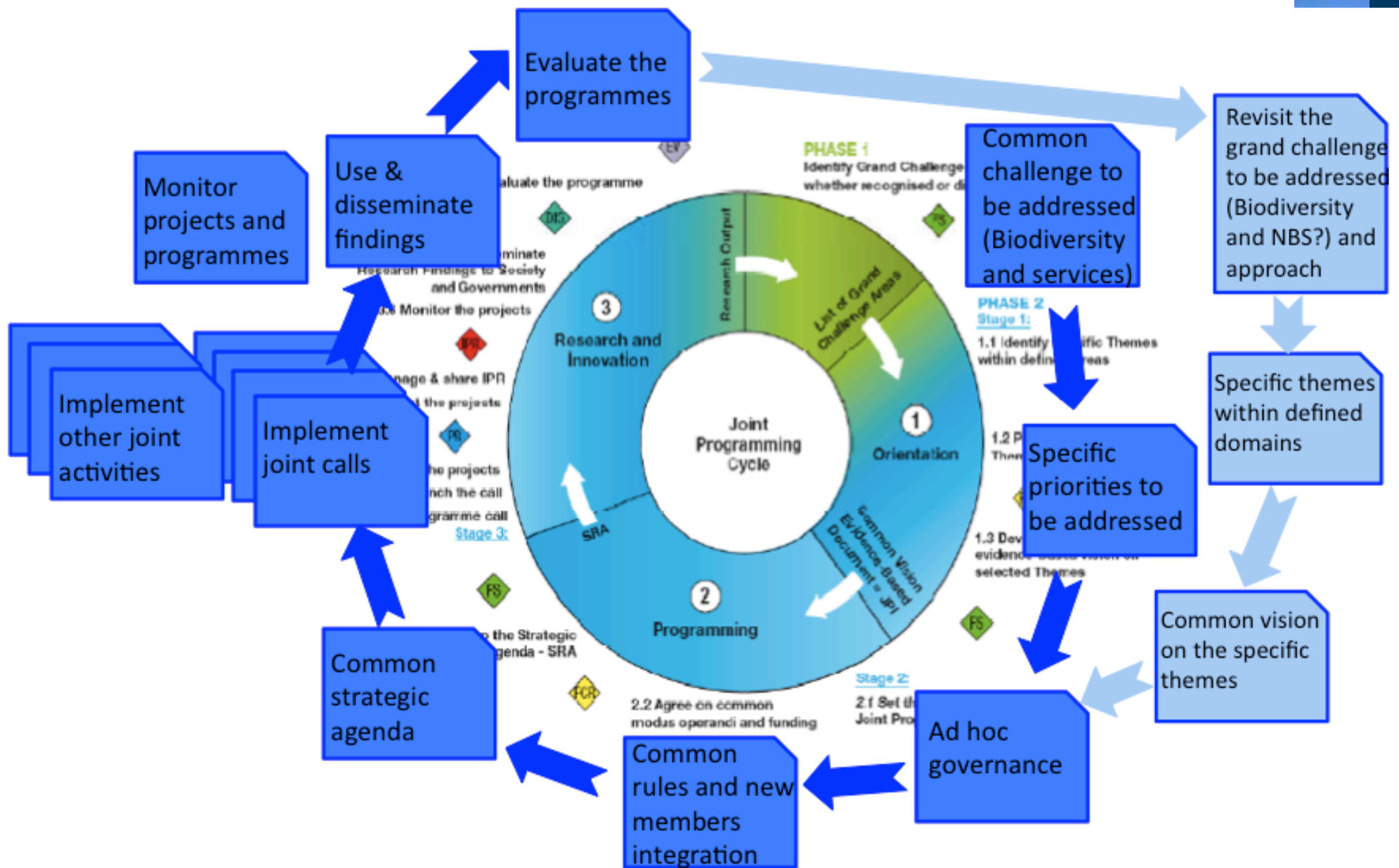

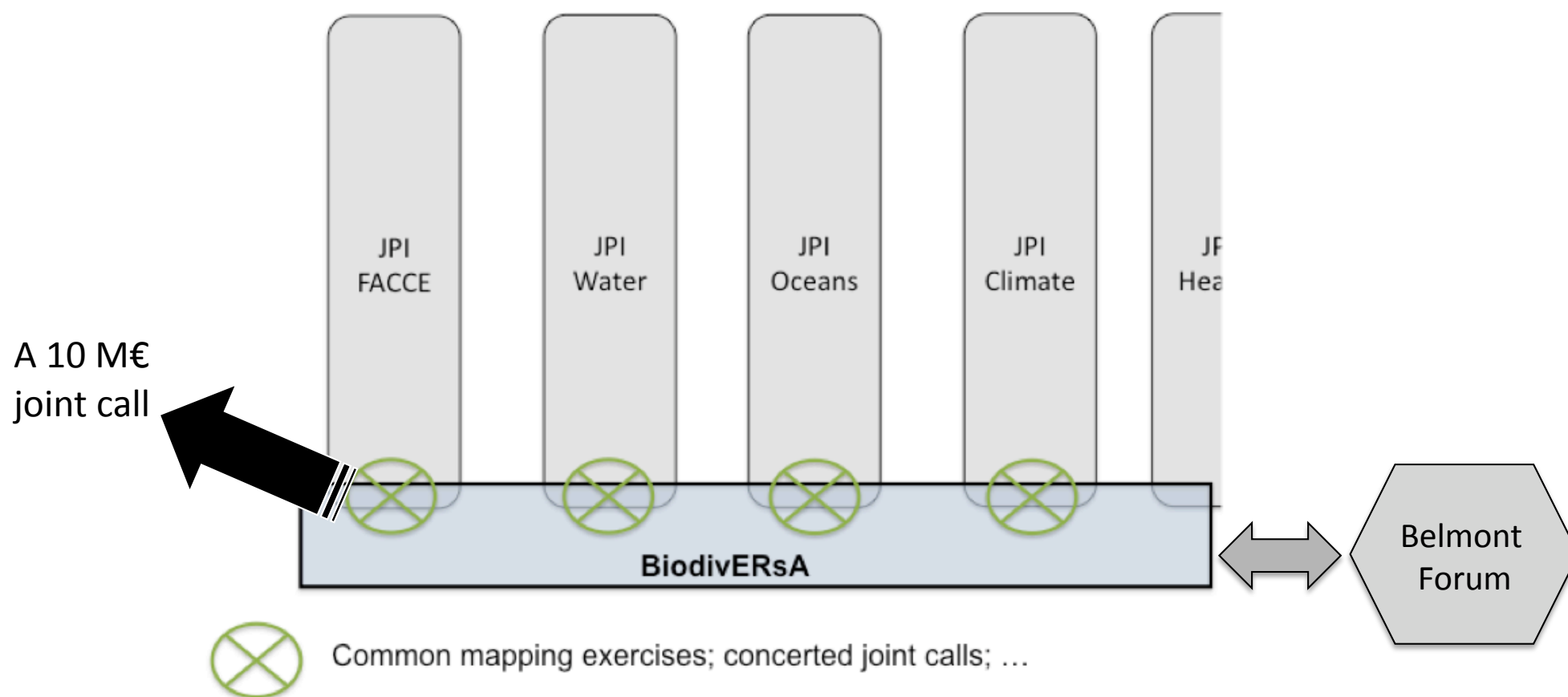
Current status of BiodivERsA



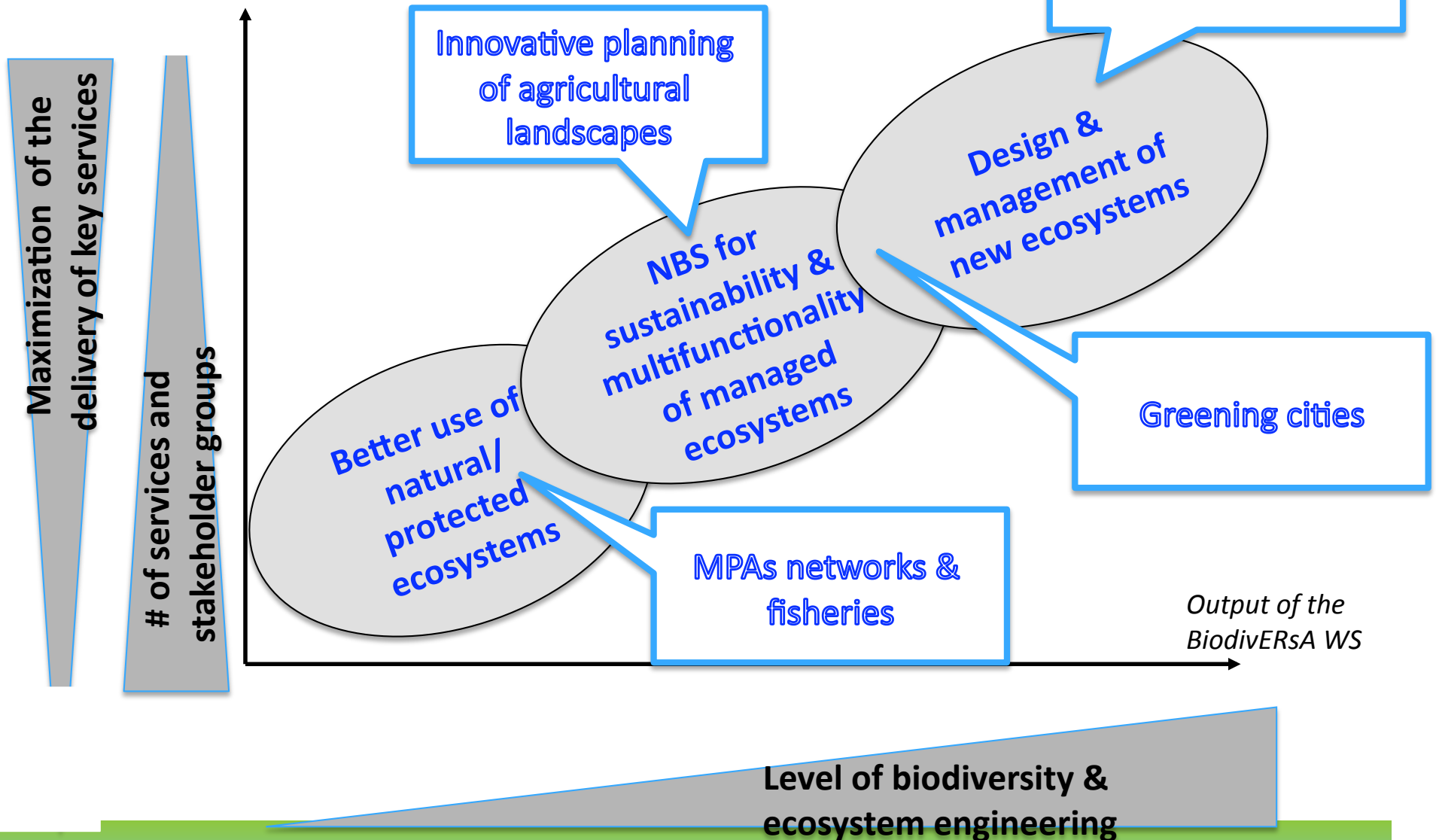
Promote knowledge base to tackle the biodiversity/Nature-based solutions grand challenge



An increased openness to ensure synergies with existing JPIs and international initiatives (e.g. Belmont Forum)

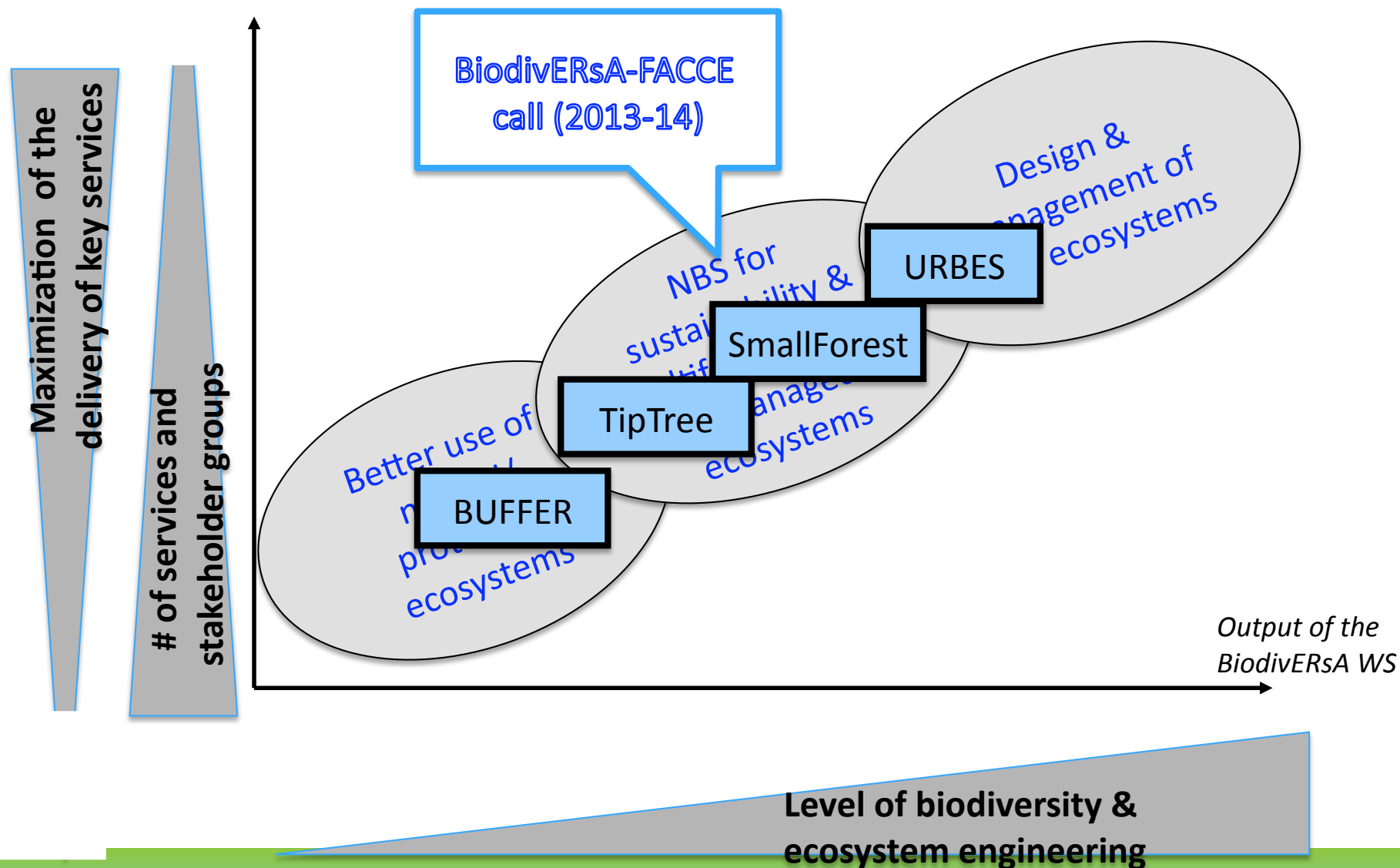


An increased interest for Nature Based Solutions-like issues





Examples of BiodivERsA NBS projects & calls



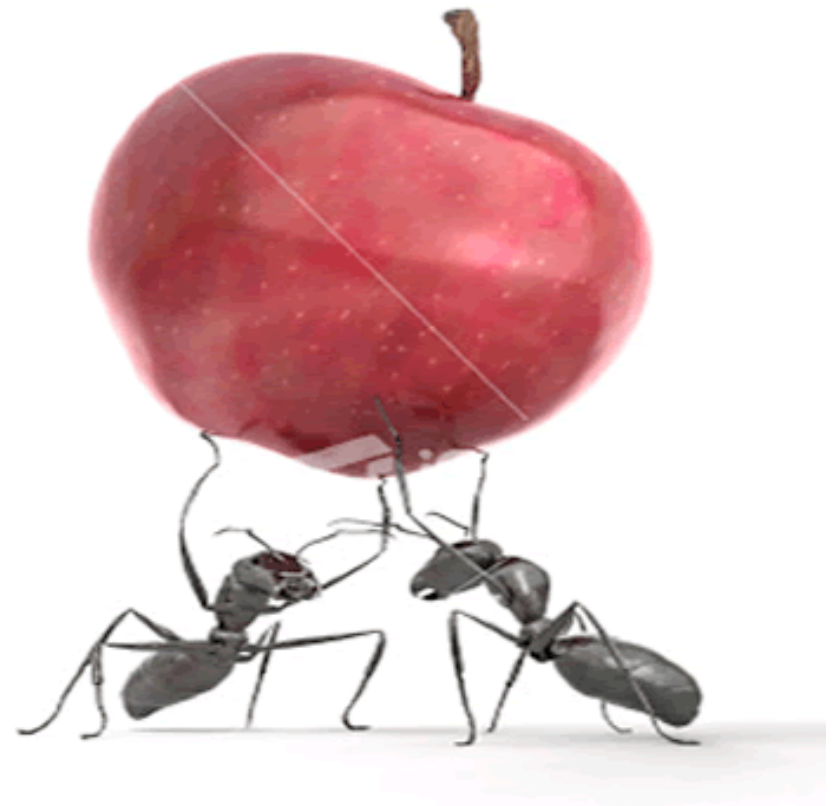


Take-home message from BiodivERsA
