Biodiversa+ is the European Partnership for Biodiversity, bringing together 83 partners from ministries and funding organisations in 41 countries (in and outside Europe). With a total budget of 800 million euros over 7 years, it is one of the largest funding programmes for biodiversity in the world. The Partnership is currently restructuring parts of the organisation, and we are now looking for a new Operational Manager to complete the management team.

### **About the Biodiversa+ partnership**

Biodiversa+ is a partnership of national and regional ministries and funding agencies, funded by the partners and co-funded by the European Commission (EC) under Horizon Europe (COFUND). Among other things, it contributes to the production and dissemination of knowledge about biodiversity through various activities:

- annual joint calls for research projects
- biodiversity monitoring activities and their harmonization at European level,
- collaboration with other European and international initiatives/bodies (e.g., NetworkNature, IPBES, GBIF),
- activities to strengthen the links between science, policy and society,
- communication and dissemination activities.

The partnership is run by the partners supported by the Operational Team (OT), which is a distributed secretariat with 23 staff members hosted by partners in France (FRB and ANR), Finland (SYKE), Belgium (BELSPO), Sweden (SEPA), Italy (BOZEN) and Denmark (SKGAV).

### **About the FRB (host organisation)**

The French Foundation for Research in Biodiversity (FRB) is the coordinating entity of Biodiversa+, hosting large parts of its OT. The FRB was created in 2008 on the initiative of the ministries in charge of research and ecology, and eight public research institutions (BRGM, CIRAD, CNRS, IFREMER, INRAE, IRD, MNHN). They have since been joined by LVMH, Ineris, the University of Montpellier and the French Biodiversity Agency (OFB), bringing the number of founding members to 11.

The Foundation's mission is to support and act with research to increase and transfer knowledge about biodiversity. The FRB is a foundation for scientific cooperation under private law. It operates independently and has about 50 employees.

Biodiversa+ is participating in NetworkNature, the European multi-stakeholder platform for nature-based solutions. The four-year project has the following objectives:

- Supporting the development of public policies in the EU, Member States and the international community by encouraging the integration and mobilisation of knowledge on NbS.
- Broadening, guiding and engaging the community of innovators, developers and practitioners around NbS.
- Strengthening the capacities and skills of public authorities, investors and entrepreneurs in NbS and of society as a whole in NbS.

Biodiversa+ is responsible for coordinating and implementing research and innovation activities, including:

- Facilitating the implementation of the European roadmap for NbS research and innovation and its update;
- Continuing the construction of a knowledge base on NbS R&I, through the mapping of NbS R&I projects and the development of a database on NbS knowledge gaps.

### **Your position**

You will be part of the Operational Team of Biodiversa+ which is central to the implementation of the partnership. It currently has 23 employees based in France, Belgium, Finland, Italy, Denmark and Sweden. You will be working in a young, dynamic, and caring environment. You will report directly to the Operational Manager overseeing Work Package 3 (WP3), based at the FRB (Paris), and will work closely with the Danish partner, co-lead of WP3.

### **Your mission**

Your task will be to monitor the implementation of activities within WP3, related to developing research and innovation to design and develop nature-based solutions, and valuing biodiversity in the private sector, and to provide support to the WP leaders and partner organisations participating in the implementation of activities linked to WP3 (80% of time). The remaining 20% will be dedicated to NetworkNature-related tasks.

### **Your activities**

- Supporting the partners involved in implementing the planned activities;
- Implementing the activities for which you are responsible (drafting documents, mapping stakeholders, organising events, etc.);
- Providing support for practical aspects (e.g., organising meetings or events) and for administrative and financial matters;
- Reporting on the activities for which you are responsible (as part of internal reporting to the partnerships and to the European Commission);
- Monitoring the proper implementation of decisions taken by the Partnership's governance bodies regarding activities.

- Participating and supporting the update of NetworkNature's database of EU R&I projects on NbS
